7. Get Parenting Support
8. Be Kind to Yourself

This term in drama, we are beginning to look at devising in year 7, Susan Coleman in year 8, DNA in year 9 and year 10 and 11 are continuing with component 1 and component 3. As always, the performing arts department welcomes any students who would like to rehearse and need space to do so. The music rooms are open every lunch time and there are plenty of spaces to rehearse after school. Year 10 and 11 are welcome to come to period 6 for revision purposes on Thursdays

Dance

The dance department is excited to get the students back moving and grooving this term!

Year 8 students have been introduced to contemporary dance and its disciplines. All students will continue to explore the techniques and challenge themselves towards producing an end of term solo/duet group performance.

Music

This term we have kicked off in music with a variety of schemes across our KS3. Year 7s will be learning how to read music and play an assortment of pieces on Keyboard, I know many of our students are looking forward to this opportunity. Year 8 students are delving into the world of film music. We will be looking at a variety of composing techniques used when composers are writing music for film clips and applying them to our own work. Year 9 students are using Bandlab software to create music for adverts and will be exploring how different musical choices create different moods for varying products. Composing is a difficult skill for many as often what we create in our head can be difficult to realise, we understand the challenges and hopefully through the practise opportunities we create students that are confident with creating their own Music! We look forward to seeing what our students can do!
