#### Performing Arts Update

#### Drama:

Year 7 have been studying the play 'The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time' and have been using explorative strategies to understand and perform parts of the play. This week, the year 7s were understanding duologues and what this entails within performance. We have focussed on different vocal and physical skills the past few weeks and these will culminate in a small duologue performance.

We have been very impressed with the commitment of the year 7s and have even had some very committed students rehearsing at break time!

#### Dance:

KS3 students have been participating in desk dancing. This involved learning a set phrase, rehearsing and performing in a classroom setting using a chair and a desk only. Students have shown great enthusiasm and enjoyed the challenge set by Miss Pilgrim.

#### Music:

Year 9 students have selected their path for this term, some are specialising in composing, others are specialising in performing. We have performances being rehearsed from a wide range of genres, some musical theatre pieces, some pop, some rap. Composers are also creating music in a wide range of styles and genres, some are creating mashups of existing tracks, some students are creating music from scratch with all their own material.




## Performing Arts Update

### Are You Eligible for Free School Meals?

If you are in receipt of any of the following, your child may be eligible for free school meals.

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, with no element of Working Tax Credit, and a household income below £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs)
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- Universal Credit income dependant

You can check your eligibility and apply for free school meals through Northampton County Council by clicking here.
