Clean, relaxed and accessible dress code

Our sixth form students are role models for our school communities and are expected to dress smartly. One of the freedoms of sixth form is that students are not required to wear a uniform. However, they must take pride in their appearance which is required to be appropriate for the school working day. They are expected to dress in a manner that is clean, relaxed, and accessible. Footwear should be appropriate.

- Smart trousers or tailored shorts
 - Skirts/Dresses (no more than 5 - 10cm above the knee)
 - Collared shirt or plain polo shirt
 - Jumper/cardigan
 - Suit (optional)
 - Blouse/top/shirt
 - Smart shoes or boots with a sensible heel
 - Hairstyles and colour must be in keeping with the business dress ethos. Hair must not be dyed excessively bright colours.
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- No hoodies
 - No ripped jeans
 - No jogging bottoms
 - No crocs or sliders
 - No football tops or tops/T-shirts with big graphics
 - No cropped, skinny strap, low cut or backless tops
 - Dark jeans only
 - Sportswear is allowed for BTEC sports students only, including
 - the compulsory TENC sports top, navy/black tracksuit bottoms,
 - black/navy tracksuit top or the TENC 3/4 zip
